## **1. Introduction**

The global pandemic Covid-19 has pushed us to a virtual world in which human beings are enforced to interact in virtual formats mostly. Meanwhile, the announcement of National Education Policy-2020 by the Government of India has called upon all the educational institutions to elaborate the policy and its career prospectives with students and other stakeholders.

In this context, Shree Ram College, Rampur has gladly accepted the challenges and conceived the idea of holding a national webinar on the educational reforms in India. Given the Covid-19 restrictions and guidelines, it has organized a National Webinar on “ Higher Education Roadmap in National Education Policy-2020 and Career Counselling” on 14<sup>th</sup> August from 10.30 A.M onwards through Google Meet platform.

## **2. Welcome Address by Dr, Rameswar Naik, Principal, SRC, Rampur**

Dr. Rameswar Naik, Principal, Shree Ram College, Rampur proudly inaugurated the unique academic event in the college. He thanked the convenor and co-convenor for conceiving and organizing the webinar with the cooperation of organizing committee members and technical experts. He warmly welcomed the distinguished resource persons joining online far away from Delhi and Bihar. He urged them to enlighten the participants with the pros and cons of the NEP-2020 along with ways forward for keeping up the core values of education.

## **3. Keynote Address by Sj. Akshaya Ku. Patra, Reader in Commerce, Convenor**

Sj. Akshaya Kumar Patra, Reader in Commerce, Convenor delivered the keynote address of the National Webinar. He historically highlighted the various education policies in India. He briefly analysed the education policies in 1968 and 1986. He thanked the Government of India for bringing up the New Education Policy after a 34 years. He evaluated the NEP-2020 and expects it to fulfil the needs of the contemporary society and economy. However, he left upon the resource persons to critically evaluate the policy and suggest constructive feedbacks for all the stakeholders.

## **4. Resource Person 01 : Dr. Mithilesh Kumar, Assistant Professor, Munger University**

Dr, Mithilesh Kumar, Assistant Professor , Munger University conceptualized the NEP-2020. He briefly highlighted the key reforms in the new policy and their implications for various stakeholders. He brought up the positive aspects of the new policy. He praised the new 5+3+3+4 curricular structure. He emphasized the role of National Research Foundation and Higher Education Commission of India for creating conducive atmosphere for research and innovation. He also expects the new assessment pattern to suit the students.

## **5. Resource Person 02: Dr. Antaryami Beriha, Academic Consultant, OSOU**

Dr. Antaryami Beriha, Academic Consultant, Odisha State Open University talked about the importance of online/distance learning. He appreciated the NEP-2020 for prioritizing the open distance learning as an alternative option for the working class. He expected the policy would cater to the educational needs of those who can't avail the formal education for many personal or professional reasons.

## **6. Resource Person 03: Dr. Santosh J, Assistant Professor, Delhi University**

Dr. Santosh J, Assistant Professor, Delhi University was very critical of NEP-2020. He disliked the multiple entry-exit options of the policy. He argued that it would affect the poor students as they might exit/ drop out from getting higher education because of various socio-economic reasons. He called it formal deprivation of education for the poor. He also criticized the proposal of starting vocational

education from class VI with internship. He advocated that this would enforce the students to stick to hereditary occupation and they would be deprived of other career opportunities. He opined that all the faculty posts lying vacant should be filled up first and then the government can think of implementing the policy. He also advocated for the increase in public investment for education.

#### **7. Resource Person 04 : Dr. Madan Meher, HOD, Department of Pol. Sc. Attabira College**

Dr. Madan Meher, Head of Department of Political Science, Attabira Colleg, Attabira was also very sceptical about the success of implementation of the policy. He brought up empirical evidence of his own college for proving his point. He pointed out that students don't have access to good library facilities, adequate textbooks or reference books, cyber library facilities, etc. He also pointed out that certain poor students can't afford to buy even a cheap smart phone and they can't attend / join online classes. He basically argued whenever the government would try to implement any new policy, it should check its viability from the perspectives of students. Student-centric approaches should be adopted to implement any policy successfully.

#### **8. Career Counselling in the Prospects of NEP-2020**

All the resource persons guided the students for prospective career options in view of NEP-2020. Dr. Kumar advised to choose honours or elective subjects wisely during under graduation in order to be competent for any profession of their choices. Dr. Beriha emphasized the roles of open distance learning in completing diverse job-oriented courses and getting diploma certificates so as to apply for the jobs. He elaborated various programmes, courses offered by various open universities and specifically by Odisha State Open University. He urged all the students participants to reap the optimum benefits of open distance learning. Dr. Santosh J and Dr. Meher also advised the students to choose their careers wisely and not to aspire for the hereditary occupations only.

#### **9. Question Answer Session**

The question answer session was well moderated by Dr. Barik. He collected all the queries or questions of the participants through the Chat Box of Google Meet and asked the resource persons to take them one by one. There were questions on ways in which the government can tackle the issues of students and faculties in NEP-2020.

#### **10. Concluding Remarks**

After the marathon question answer session, Dr. Naik delivered the concluding remarks on the webinar. He specially thanked the resource persons for elucidating the various aspects of NEP-2020 and for lively discussion. In the end, Mrs Mohanty proposed the vote of thanks to around 90-100 participants comprising resource persons, students and faculty mebers. Then the webinar was formally closed by the Principal with warm thanks.

The National Webinar is an academic landmark for the college with the virtual experiences of learning and discussion. The webinar will also help the stakeholders implementing the policy by considering the constructive feedbacks given by the resource persons.

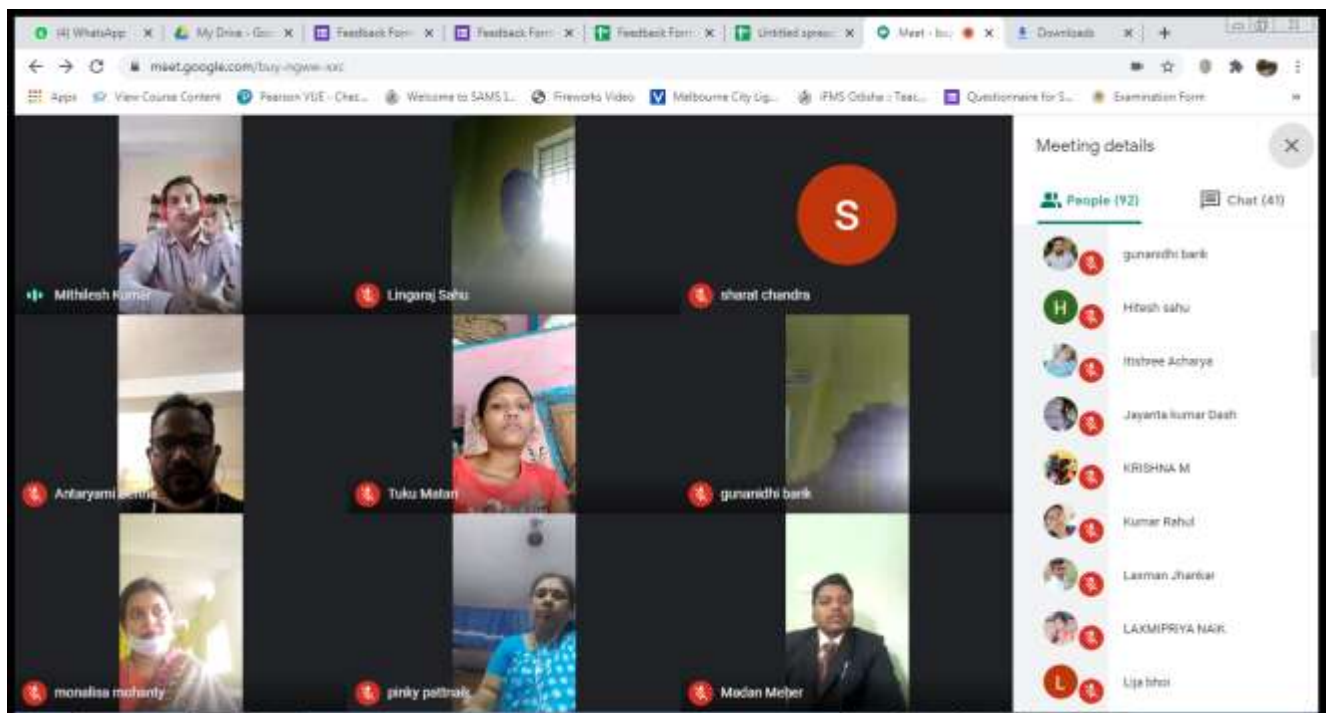
